

Learning Express Library Talking Points

- **What is Learning Express Library?**

Learning Express Library is one of the products available through the Tennessee Electronic Library (TEL). It houses free practice tests, online courses and eBooks for a variety of standardized tests, gives instant results and provides individualized plans to improve on real tests.

- **Why would people want to use it?**

Test taking can be stressful, and these days test scores mean a lot. Practicing the exam ahead of time, under similar conditions (timed and on a computer) is a good way to prepare.

- **How can teachers use this site?**

Teachers can study for PRAXIS I and II or the GRE, as well as get their students ready for PSAT, SAT, ACT, AP and CLEP exams.

- **Does it only have tests for students?**

No, Learning Express Library includes job-related practice tests for police and firefighters as well as licensure exams for cosmetologists, teachers, United States Postal workers and others.

- **Do you need a password?**

You need to create a free account in the Learning Express Library before you can take a test or start a course. Pick a username and password of your choice and add a test or course to “My Center” to get started.

- **I had an account before, and now it's not working.** Learning Express Library 3.0 is here! Everyone gets to create a new account, either with your email address or a username and password between 6-10 characters long (numbers or letters, no spaces). Learning Express 2.0 is available thru May 2014.

- **How can my patrons connect to this site?**

Go to www.tntel.info and click on “Test Prep.”

TEL is a group of online resources available for free to anyone in Tennessee. Each month, more than a million searches are made in TEL. It has genealogy resources and access to newspapers, magazines and journal articles. Check it out at www.tntel.info.
