

HeritageQuest Display Ideas

- Invite your local historical society to put up a display in your library.
- “Discover Your Roots” Showcase books from your library’s collection that help a beginning genealogist get started on their research. Books that cover doing online family history research and books about Tennessee could be helpful.
- “An Immigrant’s Story” Pull together books and movies that tell the story of the American immigrant. There are both fiction and nonfiction titles, including several biographies. Which ones are in your library?
- You can use the image on page 2 to create your own signs.
- Do you have a local history book that includes photos? Challenge your patrons to bring in current photos of the same locations, or people in the same position (like the mayor!).
- Contact your local archives ([see directory](#)) for information on county records. Be sure to know their hours and rules before sending patrons there.
- Check out the resources available in your county www.tngenweb.org . It may have exactly what your library patron needs.
